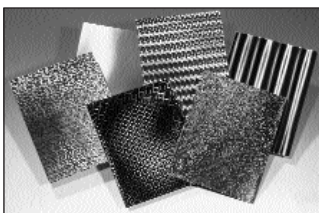

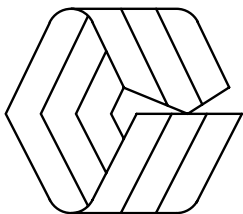
Loders Croklaan

Schimpff's honored in Indiana

Schimpff's Confectionery in Jeffersonville, Indiana, USA, has received Indiana Main Street's 2001 Historic Preservation Project award.

The annual award is given to an outstanding historic rehabilitation project located in a downtown area. Schimpff's, a 110-year-old candy company, recently expanded its site and added a museum and candy kitchen, bringing thousands of additional visitors to Jeffersonville. With the expansion, the company also renovated its existing facility, overhauling the interior and restoring the building's facade.

Schimpff's started in Louisville in the 1850s and moved to its current location in 1891.

The Jeffersonville Main Street Association noted that Schimpff's Confectionery has invested a lot of time and money in the ongoing revitalization of the properties. The Main Street Association of Jeffersonville nominated Schimpff's for the award. More than 160 cities and towns in Indiana participate in the Indiana Main Street program.
